Blessings and Responsibilities

One of the greatest comforts of being a Christian is the fact that we belong to Christ. As Paul writes, *"Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires."* Gal. 5:24

We belong to Christ because He purchased us with His blood, *"Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body,"* (1Cor. 6:19,20). In belonging to Christ we receive those blessings that can only be found in Him, *"Blessed {be} the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly {places} in Christ,"* (Eph. 1:3).

But along with this comfort and these blessings comes responsibility. As Christians we have chosen to walk a different path than that of the world, 1 John 1:7. We have chosen the path that follows the example of Christ, Heb. 12:1-3; 1 Peter 2:21. As Paul stated in Gal 5:24, it is a path wherein we have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

The flesh that we have crucified is synonymous with sinfulness. In other words we have crucified our sinful desires and passions of the flesh. Paul writes, *"knowing this, that our old self was crucified with {Him,} that our body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin; for he who has died is freed from sin,"* (Rom. 6:6,7).

As Christians we have every spiritual blessing in Christ Jesus because we have been freed from sin, but we also have the responsibility of keeping sin out of our lives. We do this by putting to death our sinful passions and desires. We seek the things above, Col 3:1-3 and we belong to Christ.
