TODAY I WILL MAKE A DIFFERENCE

REASONING TOGETHER

The Posture of Our Heart

"Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the Lord our Maker. For He is our God, and we are the people of His pasture, and the sheep of His hand." (Psa. 95:6-7) I find it interesting that often in scripture we read of people kneeling before the Lord as they offer their worship to Him, and most especially as they speak to Him in prayer. Listen to some other scriptures: Solomon *"arose from before the altar of the Lord, from kneeling on his knees with his hands spread up to heaven."* (I Kgs. 8:54) Again, speaking of Solomon, *"he...knelt down on his knees before all the congregation of Israel, and spread out his hands toward heaven."* (II Chr. 6:13) *"I fell on my knees and spread out my hands to the Lord my God."* (Ezra 9:5) Daniel *"knelt down on his knees three times that day, and prayed and gave thanks before his God..."* (Dan. 6:10) Luke speaks of Jesus as *"He knelt down and prayed."* (Luke 22:41) As he was dying, Stephen *"knelt down and cried out with a loud voice..."* (Acts 7:60)

How often have you knelt before the Lord and offered to Him the worship that He deserves? The very idea of worship is the acknowledging before God the reverence due Him. What better way to express praise and homage to Him than by prostrating oneself before His throne? I don't know that God has commanded a particular posture that one must position himself in before he can offer acceptable worship to God, or before His prayer will be heard. However, there certainly is a posture of heart that must be right if our worship is to be all that it should be! As one kneels before God, there is a humility that is being expressed: the recognition of our own lowly place, and the acknowledging of His exalted place! In our worship, we "bow before the great 'I Am.'" We may stand before God, or sit, or lie down, but there must be a prostrating of our spirit before God, recognizing that we have been granted the privilege of being in the presence of the Almighty God! Worship must not be taken lightly!!
