"A Great First Cause"

In Hebrews 3:4 when the writer states, "*For every house is built by someone, but the builder of all things is God,*" he is affirming the well-known Law of Cause and Effect. The cause is God. The effect is all things built.

As I noted last week the law of causality or cause and effect, which is the basis of the so-called scientific method, affirms that like causes produce like effects and that every effect must have an adequate cause. Dr. Robert Jastrow, considered by many to be the finest science writer today, has observed that the notion of an effect without a cause is witchcraft, not science (*Until The Sun Dies*, Warner books, New York, 1977, p.5).

In applying the Law of Cause and Effect to man's existence what do we see? Regarding the personality of man as an effect, his intelligence requires a Cause possessive of intelligence, his power of choice implies a Cause possessed of volition, his moral consciousness must be explained in terms of a Cause possessed of morality. Thus the law of causality, cause and effect, is at least strong circumstantial evidence of the existence of a great First Cause, a personal Creator-God.

It must be acknowledged that the intelligence which we possess today could not have sprung from nothing. In illustrating this point one could look to the purpose of our school system. The teachers are to teach (cause) so our children will have knowledge (effect). Are we then to suppose that over millions of years the intelligence we possess today developed by chance. Can we believe that morality comes through a process known as time. A simple experiment would prove this not to be true. Allow a child to be separated from all intelligent influences and observe what develops. In time do we see an adult with proper communication skills, as we have today? Do we find an adult with proper mathematical skills? These and many more like them are a product of the Law of cause and Effect. The cause is the teacher teaching and the effect would then be possession of these skills.

In regards to man does it seem logical that nothing and then time would have produced the intelligence, morals and freedom of choice we possess today? Or does it seem more logical and compliant with the Law of Cause and Effect that a first Great cause, possessive of intelligence, morality and choice created us with these things? So, as stated before, "the law of causality, cause and effect, is at least strong circumstantial evidence of the existence of a great First Cause, a personal Creator-God."
