During my second month of college, our professor gave us a pop quiz. I was a conscientious student and had breezed through the questions until I read the last one:

"What is the first name of the woman who cleans the school?" Surely this was some kind of joke. I had seen the cleaning woman several times. She was tall, dark-haired, and in her 50s, but how would I know her name?

I handed in my paper, leaving that question blank. Just before class ended, one student asked if the last question would count toward our quiz grade.

"Absolutely," said the professor. "In your careers, you will meet many people. All are significant. They deserve your attention and care, even if all you do is smile and say "hello."

I've never forgotten that lesson. (Her name was Dorothy.)

REASONING TOGETHER

SCIENTIFIC PROOFS FOR BIBLICAL INSPIRATION THE UNIVERSE

One of the greatest evidences we have for the existence of God is the universe itself. The Apostle Paul wrote, "...because that which is known about God is evident within them; for God made it evident to them. For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse," (Rom. 1:19,20). The psalmist declared, "*THE heavens are telling of the glory of God; And their expanse is declaring the work of His hands. Day to day pours forth speech, And night to night reveals knowledge,*" (Ps. 19:1,2).

Though some might agree that there is a "higher power," they may not agree that the Bible is His word. But a study of the Bible reveals many scientific facts that were known thousands of years before our present day scientist discovered them. Things that, without divine intervention, could not have been known by man. This type of evidence helps us to determine if the Bible is the Word of God or not.

Concerning the Universes, the Bible contains many scientific facts from the field of Astronomy. The prophet Isaiah wrote, "*It is he who sitteth upon the circle of the Earth,*" (Isa 40:22). Isaiah knew the Earth was round. In Isaiah's day and for many generations to follow, people believed the Earth was flat. Isaiah spoke just the opposite and was correct.

The psalmist spoke of the orbit of the Sun, "*Its rising is from one end of the heavens, And its circuit to the other end of them; And there is nothing hidden from its heat,*" (Ps. 19:6). Citing Dr. Bert Thompson, "For many years Bible critics scoffed at the Bible, stating that this verse taught the old, false doctrine of geocentricity (i.e., the Sun revolved around the Earth). Then, it was discovered, and only relatively recently, that the Sun is, in fact, moving through space. It is not stationary, as was once thought. In fact, it is estimated to be moving through space at about 600,000 miles per hour, in an orbit so large it would take an estimated 220,000,000 years just to complete one orbit!" (A Study Course in Christian Evidences, Apologetics Press, Montgomery AL, p.133) How is it possible that Isaiah knew the Earth was round? How is it possible that the psalmist knew the Sun was in an orbit? Were these just lucky guesses or divinely inspired writings from the Creator of the Universe?

The Bible also contains scientific facts from the field of Biology. Moses wrote, "*Then God said, 'Let the earth sprout vegetation, plants yielding seed, {and} fruit trees bearing fruit after their kind, with seed in them, on the earth'; and it was so. And the earth brought forth vegetation, plants yielding seed after their kind, and trees bearing fruit, with seed in them, after their kind; and God saw that it was good,*" (Gen. 1:11,12). See also Genesis 1:21,24. Moses was correct in his statement that all things produce after their own kind. You don't get corn from a grain of wheat and you don't get a cow from a chicken egg. This may not be big news to us today, having a better understanding of the laws of genetics and heredity. But the science of genetics was not instituted until around the year 1900.

The Apostle Paul stated that there are four fleshs - men, beasts, birds and fishes (1 Cor. 15:39). Today this is a commonly known fact. All of these fleshs are different in their biochemical makeup. But how did Paul, writing some 1900 years ago know this?

The Bible reveals many scientific facts from the fields of Astronomy and Biology, that man could not have known without Divine intervention. The fact that these are found within the Bible lends credibility to it being the word of God. How else could man have known these things thousands of years ago? Just a lucky guess?
