Reasoning Together

"How Shall We Live?" Part 6

In my last article I had been addressing the issue of why God is deserving of our love. I stated, God deserves our love because of what He has done for us. Today I would like to offer a second reason why God is deserving of our love. Before I begin, it should be clearly understood that when I say "God is deserving of our love" this implies we show this love by being obedient to His will, John 14:15.

The second reason God is deserving of our love is seen in what He is doing for us presently. God began by creating mankind and giving him an opportunity to live in His mighty presence, Gen. 1,2. Through his disobedience to God man separated himself from that which was offered, Gen. 3:1-24, but God did not give up on mankind. God's patience with man was ultimately seen when He sent His Son to pay the penalty for our sins, 1Pet. 3:18. This being accomplished, mankind was able to come back into a right relationship with Him, John 3:16. For those who are Christians this has already taken place, Rom. 5:8-10; Rom 6:3-14. Now there are the continual blessings we receive as a child of God. Let us look at a few of those blessings God continues to pour upon His children.

First, although Christians have been reconciled to God through the blood of His Son, the temptation to sin is still ever present. Yet, we are not without hope. God provides a way to endure whatever temptations might come our way, "No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, that you may be able to endure it," (1Cor. 10:13; see also Phil 4:13). It might seem difficult at times to continue on in the Christian walk, but God is always there helping His children along the way. Some will say, "God didn't help me in that temptation because I gave in to it." Is the problem God or you? It is written "but with the temptation (God) will provide the way of escape also." The problem is, those who give in to the temptation did not follow the way of escape provided.

Second, if we do give into the temptations of sin, God will not forsake us, but will continue to cleanse us. In 1John 1:7 we read, "but if we walk in the light as He Himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin." The key to this verse is found in the word, "cleanses." In the original Greek language this word is in the 3rd person, singular, present, indicative, active voice. Which simply means, the blood of Jesus is presently and continually cleansing each Christian as they walk in the light. In further support of this we need only read what is written a few verses later, where John states, "My little children, I am writing these things to you that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous; and He Himself is the propitiation for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for {those of} the whole world," (1John 2:1,2). What a wonderful blessing to know that if I do sin after becoming a Christian, God continues to forgive me. It must be added that confession and repentance of the sin committed is also required, 1John 1:9; Rev. 2:5.

As can be seen, what God is doing for us presently is another reason to love Him. The sin which separated us from Him and His glory has been removed in His Son, through our obedience to His will, Heb. 5:9; Acts 2:38. If after becoming a Christian we are tempted to sin He will provide a way of escape so that we might endure. If we give in to our fleshly desires and sin, God will not forsake us but will continually cleanse us through the blood of His Son, if we will only confess, repent and continue to walk in the light.
