## The Necessity of God's Word

Have you ever wondered what life would be like without God's word to guide us? Imagine man left to himself, deciding right and wrong. Imagine man being the ultimate authority in all matters. Imagine Communism or Humanism, because in their purest sense they state there is no God or word of God. In both, man is the ultimate power and prime director of all situations. Man decides the best direction for a better life. But as we know these beliefs have yet to produce a Utopian society. As a matter of fact Communism has produced a failed economy and a generation of people without hope. So, whether we realize it or not, it is important for all mankind to understand the necessity of God's word and in 2 Timothy 3:1-17 we see this.

As Paul begins he warns Timothy, *"But realize this, that in the last days difficult times will come,"* 2 Tim. 3:1. Paul proceeds to explain why these difficult times will come, 2 Tim. 3:2-9,13. Suffice it to say, man will seek his own ways above the ways of God. To combat this Timothy is told to continue in the things he has learned from the sacred writings since childhood. These are the things that are "able to save his soul," 2 Tim 3:12-15. Paul ends by explaining why this is so. He writes *"All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work,"* 2 Tim 3:16,17. Let's look more closely at this passages of scripture and come to see the necessity of God's word.

The word used here for Scripture, "graphe," always means the inspired sacred writings. These writings belong to God. This is backed up by the fact that they are "inspired," which literally means "God breathed," 1 Thess. 2:13.

As Paul continues he gives Timothy four purposes for the Scriptures. First they are "for teaching." If someone is to know God's will they must come to these Scriptures. Second they are "for reproof." When someone is in error he needs to have the truth proven and established in his mind. The Scriptures convict one of his error and prove what is right. Third they are "for correction." The Greek word for correction is the idea of setting straight or correcting to a right posture. For those who have wandered off the course the Scriptures will bring them back. Fourth they are "for training in righteousness." This is *"pideia,"* the bringing up of a child. In a spiritual since we start out as a child. But as we grow and mature we are trained in the ways of righteousness. In the end the scriptures make the man of God, "adequate and equipped for every good work." The scriptures make man complete so that he can do the work God has asked of him.

What an encouragement for us. We do not have to live in a society built upon the fallible and changing way of man, but upon the unchanging and infallible ways of God. We have God's word with us and we can know that in all things we are pleasing to Him and we are equipped for every good work. Without God's word we are lost.
