“Bible Relevance and Marriage”

Most would agree that we live in a society where couples are having a harder time staying married. But if people would understand and follow what God has to say concerning matrimony we would see a drastic change in this societies marriage problems. One might ask, “How is the Bible relevant to my marriage relationship?”

To begin we must understand that marriage was designed and instituted by God. In Genesis 2:22 we read, “*And the LORD God fashioned into a woman the rib which He had taken from the man, and brought her to the man.*” Three verses later Moses writes, “*And the man and his wife were both naked and were not ashamed,*” (Gen. 2:25). We can also turn to Matthew 19:6, “*Consequently they are no longer two, but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let no man separate.*” As seen here it is God who joins the man and the woman together in marriage.

By the fact that God is the one who instituted the marriage relationship and by the fact that it is God who joins man and woman together in marriage; it is clear that the Bible is relevant when we speak of marriage.

Consider this; where do we as a society get the idea that a men and women should marry? Why is there a need for a man and a woman to be married? Can we not be like animals and take a mate whenever the “mood” strikes us? Yet, for some reason we as a society have chosen to follow the pattern of men and women being united in marriage. The source of this pattern is God as seen in the Bible. Again, because of this the Bible is relevant to the marriage relationship. God being the designer of marriage has giving us abundant instructions on how to make a marriage work.

Next week we will look at how the Bible can guide and help our relationship be the best that it can.
