Bees Outsmart Scientists

Scientists have long recognized that bees are intelligent creatures. Many believe that this intelligence is the product of millions of years of natural selection. But the extremely fast learning ability of the bee puts in doubt the millions of years and instead shows the hand of the Creator.

Researchers at Princeton University decided to find out whether bees were smart enough to find their food source if it was moved. The researchers moved the prime food source fifty meters farther from the hive. It took the bees less than one minute to locate the moved food source. The men then moved the food source another fifty meters away. The bees still took less than a minute to find the food source. Two more moves, each a precise fifty meters, produced the same results.

However, the bees had also been studying the researchers. Before the researchers could move the food another fifty meters, they found the bees had discovered the pattern and were already waiting at the new location!

God is our Creator and has clearly left evidence of His handiwork —His fingerprints—in the creation itself. For those who have eyes to see, this fills us with wonder, and yes, with love for the Creator God who first loved us.

What Can Christians Do About Racial Prejudice?

One of the truly tragic problems in our society is racial prejudice.

Jesus was born into a very prejudiced society, and He worked to break down the barriers. To the first-century Jew, there was nothing worse than a Gentile, except a Samaritan. Jesus, however, showed the brotherhood of all mankind with His Parable of the Good Samaritan, in which a hated Samaritan showed himself to be the good neighbor to the Jew who had been beaten and robbed on the road to Jericho (Luke 10).

Racial prejudice has no place in the heart of any Christian. James wrote, *"Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself . . . if ye have respect to persons, ye commit sin"* (James 2:8-9). We must treat people of other races as we wish to be treated, which is Christ's Golden Rule: *"All things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets"* (Matthew 7:12).

"There is no respect of persons with God" (Romans 2:11). God does not show favoritism for one person or one race over another. All are equal in His sight. Jesus died for all people, and came to unite the world in Himself (1 John 2:2).

Conquest of prejudice begins in the home. Parents must bring up their children *"in the nurture and admonition of the Lord"* (Ephesians 6:4). This includes teaching children the brotherhood of man, the necessity of respecting all people, and the creation of all men in God's image (Genesis 1:26-27).

Paul wrote, *"There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus"* (Galatians 3:28). Paul was not saying that there are no differences between Jews and Gentiles, the free man and the slave, or males and females. He was saying that all are equal in God's sight, and all deserve respect.

We must foster the spirit of brotherly love among races. As the children's song reminds us, "Red and yellow, black and white, they are precious in His sight." *"If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?"* (1 John 4:20).
