Our Obligation to the Truth

No child of God should be satisfied with a shallow knowledge of the Bible. To this end, the apostle Paul said, "Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you" (Colossians 3:16). Christians have the responsibility to handle "accurately the word of truth" (2 Timothy 2:15).

Preachers must "speak the things which are fitting for sound doctrine" (Titus 2:1). Being "ready in season" and "out of season" they must "reprove, rebuke, exhort with great patience and instruction" (2 Timothy 4:2).

Elders must be "able to teach" (1 Timothy 3:2). And, they must hold fast "the faithful word which is in accordance with the teaching" so that they may "exhort in the sound doctrine" as well as "refute those who contradict" (Titus 1:9).

Men must hold "the mystery of faith with a clear conscience" (1 Timothy 3:9), in order to be qualified as deacons.

Teachers are warned that they "shall incur a stricter judgment" (James 3:1). This is stated in order to stress the awesome obligation teachers have to teach the truth.

All Christians must be "ready to make a defense to every one who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you" (1 Peter 3:15). No child of God should ever be wishy-washy or unsure concerning the faith.

Our teaching should be clear and not confusing. The apostle Peter reminds us, "whoever speaks, let him speak, as it were, the utterances of God" (1 Pet. 4:11).

13 Characteristics of the Christian Life

In the book of Hebrews, the thirteenth chapter we find the following thirteen characteristics of the Christian life.

1. A Christian loves the brethren. *“Let love of the brethren continue”* (v. 1).
2. A Christian shows hospitality to strangers. *“Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers”* (v. 2).
3. A Christian shows sympathy to those in trouble. *“Remember the prisoners, as though in prison with them, and those who are ill-treated”* (v. 3).
4. A Christian maintains moral purity in his life. *“Marriage is to be held in honor among all, and the marriage bed is to be undefiled”* (v. 4).
5. A Christian is content being free from the love of money. *“Make sure that your character is free from the love of money, being content with what you have”* (v. 5).
6. A Christian is not afraid because he knows that God will be with him. *“We confidently say, “The LORD is my helper, I will not be afraid. What will man do to me”* (v. 6).
7. A Christian follows good examples. *“Remember those who led you, who spoke the word of God to you; and considering the result of their conduct, imitate their faith”* (v. 7).
8. A Christian knows what he believes and is not carry away by false doctrine. *“Do not be carried away by varied and strange teachings”* (v. 9).
9. A Christian serves because we recognize that we live under a better system. *“We have an altar from which those who serve the tabernacle have no right to eat”* (v. 10).
10. A Christian continually offers praise to God with his mouth. *“Let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that give thanks to His name”* (v. 15).
11. A Christian does good by sharing what he has. *“Do not neglect doing good and sharing, for with such sacrifices God is pleased”* (v. 16).
12. A Christian obeys his leaders. *“Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they keep watch over your souls as those who will give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with grief, for this would be unprofitable for you”* (v. 17).
13. A Christian prays for others. *“Pray for us”* (v. 18).

How many of these characteristics are demonstrated in your life? Let's made a conscious effort to incorporate all of them into our lives. May they become so much a part of us that we do not have to make a conscious effort to accomplish them, but rather that they are just part of our life.
