A Surpassing Righteousness

Righteousness is a standard of conduct. It is the right way of doing things; the right way to live. The scribes and Pharisees developed a system of righteousness, but it was not God's righteousness. Jesus came to reveal God's system of righteousness, which surpassed that of the scribes and Pharisees. From Matthew 5 we learn that righteousness has something to do with,

1. Treatment of Brothers (vs. 31-26). The scribes and Pharisees allowed mistreatment of brothers as long as it did not go as far as murder (which would be a violation of their Mosaic Law). But the righteousness, which Jesus advocates, does not even allow name-calling nor will it allow you to hypocritically continue attending worship when you have mistreated your brother.

2. Marital Purity (vs. 27-32). The scribes, and Pharisees righteousness allowed a man to divorce his wife for any cause, especially if he found another woman he desired more. But Jesus, righteousness not only forbids divorcing and remarrying (except in the case of spousal fornication), it also condemns lustful desire.

3. Your Word (vs. 33-37). The scribes and Pharisees had creative ways of breaking vows so that folks did not have to keep promises made. But Jesus, righteousness demands that your word be your bond.

4. Personal Mistreatment (vs. 38-42). The scribes and Pharisees advocated retaliation for any mistreatment received. But Jesus, righteousness has no room for the vengeful attitude.

5. Love (vs. 43-48). The righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees would have you love those who love you and hate those who hate you. But Jesus, righteousness requires you to love all men, even those who abuse you.

When you look carefully at the two systems, it becomes obvious that the manner of the scribes, and Pharisees religion offers nothing unique from the ways of the world. People of the world approve of name calling, divorce for any cause, breaking contracts, revenge and hatred.

If a Christian participates in name-calling, divorce for any reason whatsoever, breaking his word, revenge, or hatred, then what can we say about his righteousness,

'For I say to you, that unless your righteousness surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees, you shall not enter the kingdom of heaven. (Matthew 5:20)

The Heavens Declare

Our universe is filled with awesome wonders. There are billions of galaxies, each containing billions of stars, each one named by the Creator (Isaiah 40:26). Even the configurations of the stars in the heavens have a purpose (Job 38:31-33).

The "Knowledge" of the Night

We live in a time when our knowledge of the heavens is expanding quickly. Our knowledge should lead us to praise God for His amazing provision and protection. The cause of the laws of nature is not found in nature, but beyond nature. The heavens declare evidence for creation by its beauty, size, and order.

Our galaxy is called the Milky Way. It is shaped in a spiral, like a spinning octopus. The spiral arms and center of our galaxy are bright because there are many stars close together. Our galaxy is different from many other galaxies. Older, smaller, elliptical, and irregular galaxies do not contain the right amounts of elements necessary to form the proper balance of stars and planets needed to support life.

Some stars explode into supernovas. Deadly radiation flows through nearby stars and planets. The center and arms of galaxies are flooded with high amounts of radiation. Most stars are located in places with too much harmful energy for life.

Our solar system is located in the outer regions of the Milky Way. Most of the stars in our galaxy are in the larger spiral arms or in the center. There are few stars near us. Because of this, there is a low amount of radiation surrounding our solar system, and we can observe the rest of the universe and our own galaxy much better.

There is much more evidence from the universe in the Physical Sciences.
